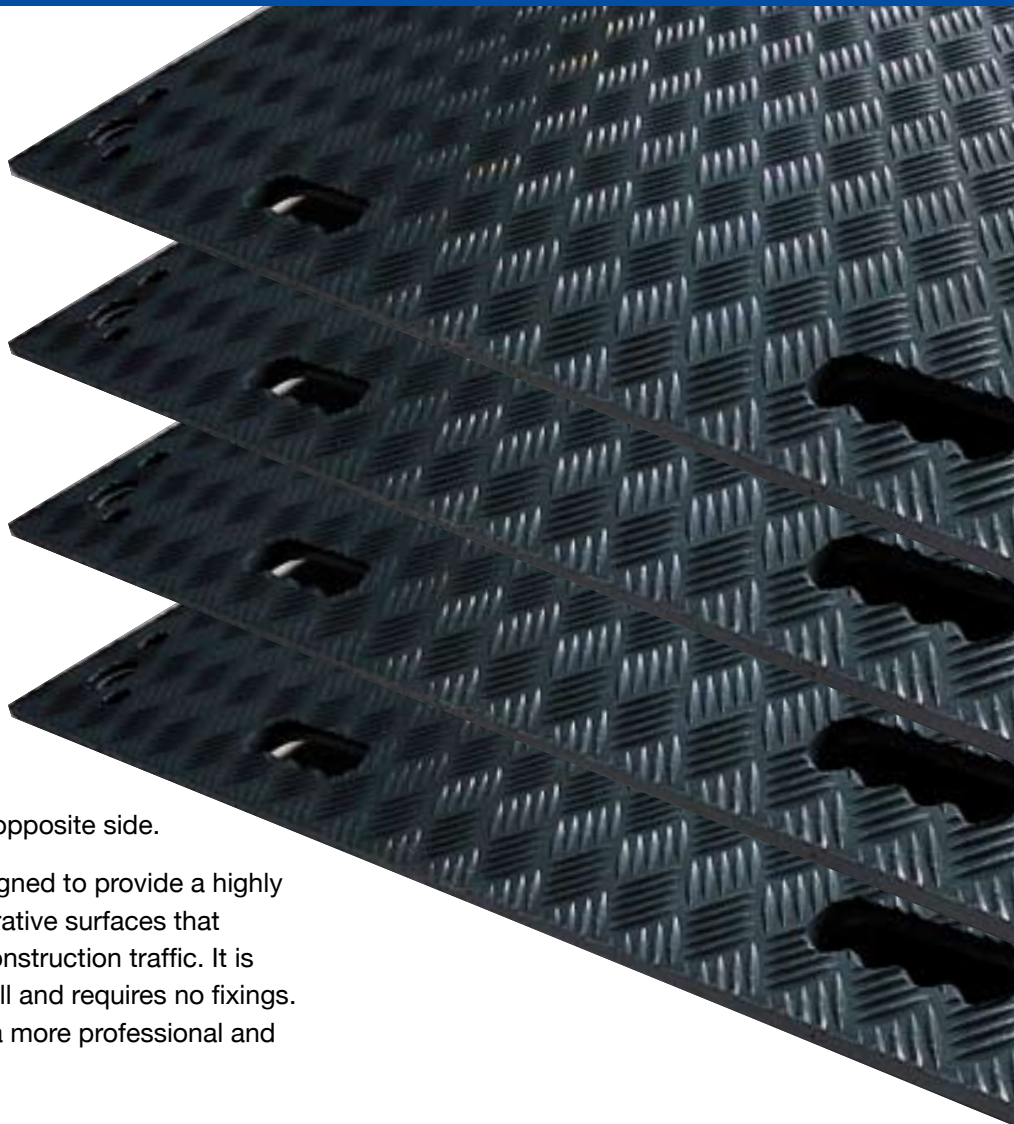
The GroundMate® System

GroundMate is a new ground protection system developed to preserve grass surfaces and sensitive ground from machinery, vehicles and pedestrian traffic. Manufactured in the UK from 100% recycled polyethylene, it is reusable - again and again - and is fully recyclable after use.

It is currently available in two formats:

GroundMate ground protection mats provide incredible value and efficient ground cover. Suitable for pedestrian and light to medium weight vehicular traffic. It is currently available in grey with an anti-slip tread pattern finish on one side and a 'diamond embossed' finish on the opposite side.

GroundMate LT (lite) - a thinner mat designed to provide a highly effective cover for hard, firm and/or decorative surfaces that need protection from vehicles, such as construction traffic. It is lightweight, cost-effective, simple to install and requires no fixings. As it can be used repeatedly, it provides a more professional and cost effective solution than plywood.

Simple connection

GroundMate is supplied pre-drilled with holes to allow easy connection and fixing. The panels can be laid longitudinally and/or horizontally and can be connected using either specially developed 2-way and 4-way GroundMate connectors or standard 'top hat' connectors. Standard GroundMate panels can be easily lifted or dragged into position by two men using the pre-formed hand-holds. A 'dragging hook' is available to aid installation.
