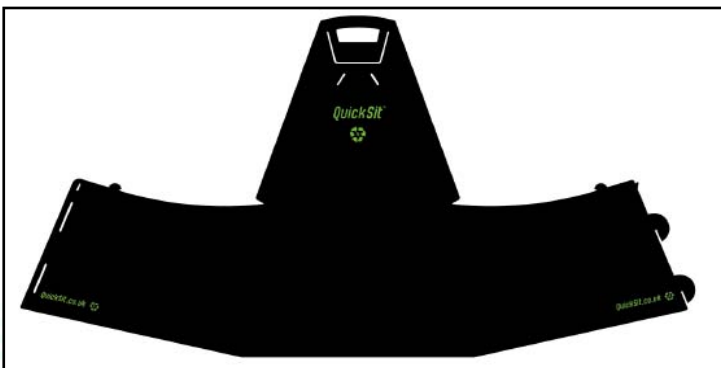

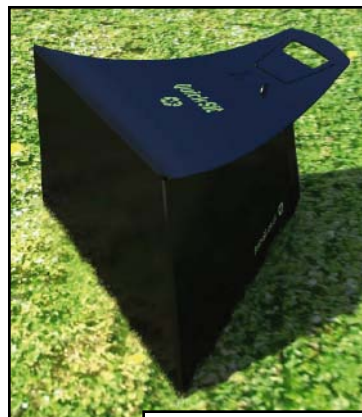


He explains:
